**AN ACT Relating to Bounty on Bobcats.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 38, § 77, amended.** The 1st sentence of section 77 of chapter 38, of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'There shall be a bounty of \$15 for every bobcat, loup cervier and Canada lynx, and \$20 for every bobcat which is killed within the state, to be paid by the treasurer of state to the person killing the same upon compliance with the following conditions.'
