**RESOLVE, Appropriating Money to Restore the Early Records in the  
Office of the Register of Probate for York County.**

---

**Records in the office of the register of probate, appropriation for.**  
**Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$900 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1938, and \$900 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1939, for repairing and rebinding the early records of the registry of probate, York county; this appropriation to be expended under the direction of the judge of probate of York county.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

These probate records date back to the year of 1687, and include wills, all administrative papers, partitions of real estate and other auxiliary records.

These records cover not only estates in York county, but all estates during that period in the state of Maine.
