AN ACT Defining the Word "Chauffeur".

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 29, § 36, amended. Section 36 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended so that the 5th paragraph thereof shall read as follows :

'The word "chauffeur" as herein used shall mean any person who operates a motor vehicle ~~other than his own~~, and ~~who, directly or indirectly~~, receives compensation for any work or services in connection therewith ; but as used elsewhere generally in this chapter with the respect to the use and operation of motor vehicles, the word "operator" and "driver" shall include the word "chauffeur."
