STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Punishing the Driver of a Motor Vehicle Found Guilty of Habitual Carelessness, Criminal Negligence, or Driving Under the Influence of Intoxicating Liquor, Injuring the Person or Property of Another.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Revocation of license. The license of any person, who drives upon any way, a motor vehicle and does injury to the person or property of another, and is found guilty of habitual carelessness, criminal negligence, or of driving such vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating liquor, shall forthwith be revoked by the secretary of state, who shall not again license or permit such person to operate a motor vehicle for 5 years from the date of such revocation.
