STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Mortgage of Household Furniture.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Mortgage of household furniture. No mortgage on household furniture which is exempt from attachment, given after the 1st day of July, 1937, shall be valid except to secure the purchase price of the same.

Sec. 2. Repealing clause. All acts or parts of act inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or amended to conform with the provisions hereof.
