IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Registration of House Trailers and Camp Trailers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, § 54, amended. Section 54 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the 3d paragraph in subdivision "c" the following: 'House trailers and camp trailers of the covered wagon type shall be registered and pay a fee of \$10 for such registration.'
