STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Provide for the Payment of a Bounty on Bears in the County of Franklin.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 79, amended. Section 79 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end of the 2nd paragraph thereof the following paragraph:

'Provided, however, that a bounty of \$10 for each and every bear killed in the county of Franklin shall be paid to persons killing the same, according to the following provisions of this section; and provided further that the first and second paragraphs of this section shall not apply to this paragraph.'
