**AN ACT Relating to the Establishment and Maintenance of Stations or
Police Barracks for Weighing Trucks.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

P. L., 1935, c. 137, § 6, amended. Section 6 of chapter 137 of the public laws of 1935 is hereby amended to read as follows :

'Sec. 6. Appropriation. For the establishment and maintenance of said stations, or police barracks there shall be appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of ~~\$8000~~ \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~1936~~ 1938, and ~~\$8000~~ \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~1937~~ 1939.'
