AN ACT Relating to Enforcement of Tax Liens.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

P. L., 1933, c. 244, additional. Chapter 244 of the public laws of 1933 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 6 and to read as follows :

‘Sec. 6. Ten days in which to make payment; not to commit waste; penalty. After 10 days from the service of such notice, any person who, without the written consent therefor from the municipal officers of the town in which the property is situated, enters on said property and cuts, detaches or removes any part thereof, including trees growing thereon or which may have been cut therefrom prior to the service of said notice, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than 11 months, or by both such fine and imprisonment, and said town may by action of debt obtain from said person double the amount of the value of any property so cut or detached or removed.’
