IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relative to Powers of State Liquor Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1935, c. 179, § 1, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 1 of chapter 179 of the public laws of 1935 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The commission shall have **exclusive** power to import spirits and wines **or to license importation by individuals for their own use, on payment of an importer's fee of \$5 per year,** and shall have exclusive control of the sale of all liquors.'
