STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Empower Towns and Cities to Establish Pensions and Retirements for Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. General system of pensions and retirements provided for. Towns and cities may enact by-laws or ordinances to establish and maintain a general system of pensions and retirements for the benefit of their officers, agents, servants and employees, with necessary classifications and terms of admission; to provide that upon the establishment of any system of pensions and retirements the officers, agents, servants and employees theretofore or thereafter appointed shall be eligible, subject to such exceptions, limitations and restrictions as may be deemed expedient to admission to such pension or retirement system.
- Sec. 2. Administration. Towns and cities enacting such by-laws or ordinances as provided in section I are hereby authorized to establish such board for the administration of said fund as it deems expedient.
- Sec. 3. Appropriation may be made by municipality. Towns and cities enacting by-laws or ordinances under the provisions of this act and establishing pensions and retirements are empowered to make appropriations for contribution to such system.
