STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Registration of Stone-crushers, Well-drillers, Steam Shovels, Graders, Rollers and Wood-sawing Outfits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, § 54, amended. Section 54 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the 5th paragraph of subdivision "c" the following:

'stone-crushers, steam shovels, graders, rollers, well-drillers permanently mounted and wood-sawing equipment permanently mounted, shall be registered and a fee of \$10 shall be paid for such registration.'
