## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Propagation of Lobsters, Shad, etc.

Rearing station for propagation of lobsters, shad, etc., established. Resolved: That the sum of \$20,000 be and hereby is appropriated for the purpose of establishing a lobster hatchery and rearing station for the propagation of lobsters, shad and other salt water fish, the same to be expended under the direction of the department of sea and shore fisheries.
