**RESOLVE, in Favor of John S. Nelson, Representative of the Penobscot
Tribe of Indians.**

Appropriation for Indians' representative. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to be paid to John S. Nelson, representative of the Penobscot tribe of Indians at the 88th legislature, the sum of \$200 for attendance, and \$18 for mileage; said sums to be paid from the appropriation for legislative expenses.
