RESOLVE, Changing the Name of Greeley Pond.

Greeley pond; name changed. Resolved: That Greeley pond, so-called, located in the towns of Readfield and Mt. Vernon, shall be hereafter known as Torsey lake.

STATEMENT OF FACTS
