AN ACT Relating to Jurisdiction of Trial Justices in Juvenile Cases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1933, c. 1, §§ 375, 376, 387, 390, 391, 392 and 393, amended. Where-
ever appear the words "trial justice", "or trial justice", "or any trial jus-
tice", "or justice", or "justice or", in sections 375, 376, 387, 390, 391, 392
and 393 of chapter 1 of the public laws of 1933, the same hereby are stricken
out, except the words "trial justices" in line 6 of said section 392.
