AN ACT Relating to Automobile Junk Yards.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Establishment of automobile junk yards, regulated. No automobile dump, or "automobile graveyard", so-called, where old, discarded, worn-out or junked automobiles, or parts thereof are gathered together shall be established without first obtaining a permit to so do from the municipal officers of the town wherein said dump is to be established.
