RESOLVE, Relating to Coordination of State Inspection Work.

State inspection work, coordinated. Resolved: That the governor and council make a study of the various inspection and collection agencies within the various departments of the state with a view to coordinating these services so that duplication and overlapping of effort and expense may be eliminated. As a result of this study, the governor and council shall formulate a plan which shall be put into effect immediately, and shall report to the 89th legislature recommendations for such legislation as may be deemed advisable to permanently avoid such duplication and overlapping.
