**RESOLVE, Granting Authority to the Forestry Department to Convey
Certain Land.**

Forestry department authorized to sell certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey the following described lot to Alice V. Dunbar, of Sullivan, for the sum of \$10.81: 15 acres of land in Township 7, South Division, Hancock county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This land, reputed to be owned by Harvey W. Dunbar of Sullivan, was acquired by the forest commissioner in behalf of the state in 1933 for non-payment of 1931 taxes. The taxes in arrears with interest and advertising to February 1, 1937 amount to \$10.81. Check for this amount is now in the hands of the state tax assessor.
