**RESOLVE, Granting Authority to the Forestry Department to Convey
Certain Land.**

Forestry department authorized to convey certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey the following described lot to Leo M. Taylor, of Topsfield for the sum of \$69.90: 174 acres of land in Township 7, Range 2, north of Bingham's Penobscot purchase, Washington county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This land, reputed to be owned by Wesley McDonough, of Carroll, was acquired by the forest commissioner in behalf of the state in 1935 for non-payment of 1933 taxes and in 1936 for non-payment of 1934 taxes. Leo M. Taylor, of Topsfield, who holds a mortgage on this land, desires to take it over by paying the taxes in arrears which figured to February 1, 1937 with interest and advertising \$69.90. Check for this amount is now in the hands of the state tax assessor.
