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AN ACT Relating to Terms of Office of State Officials.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Terms of office.** Heads and bureau chiefs of state departments and agencies, notwithstanding the term of their office, shall hold office until their successors are duly appointed and qualified.
