**RESOLVE, in Favor of Ernest R. Woodbury, of Saco.**

---

**Ernest R. Woodbury, pension for. Resolved:** That there be and hereby is appropriated to be paid, out of the appropriation for teachers' pensions, to Ernest R. Woodbury of Saco, in the county of York, the sum of \$500 per year, during the lifetime of the said Woodbury, the sum to be paid in quarterly installments.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Ernest R. Woodbury of Saco was graduated from Bowdoin College in 1895. He taught 5 years at Fryeburg Academy, from 1895 to 1900. From 1900 to 1905 he taught at Kimball Union Academy, Meriden, New Hampshire and from 1905 to the present time has taught at Thornton Academy, Saco.
