RESOLVE, Closing the Fishway at Gardners Lake.

Fishway at Gardners lake, closed. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation closing the fishway at one of the outlets of Gardners lake and also closing the Fishway stream and Gardners Lake stream (so-called) from Gardners lake to the East Machias river, in the town of East Machias.
