**RESOLVE, Relating to Ice Fishing in Eagle Lake and St. Froid Lake in
Aroostook County.**

Ice fishing, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Eagle lake and St. Froid lake in Aroostook county to ice fishing for cusk chubs and smelts from the time ice forms in the said lakes until it goes out in the spring; and to ice fishing for all fish during the months of February, March and April.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Almost every lake and pond in Aroostook county is open to ice fishing and we are requesting that Eagle lake and St. Froid lake be the same.
