**RESOLVE, Relating to Atlantic Salmon Fishing in Certain Waters.**

---

**Fishing for Atlantic salmon in certain waters regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation closing all waters and their tributaries, southwest of a line drawn between Leighton Point, so-called, in Pembroke, and Denbow Point, so-called, in Lubec, to fishing for Atlantic salmon except by customary means of rod and reel.
