**RESOLVE, Relating to Taking of Clams in Milbridge.**

---

**Taking clams in Milbridge, regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation forbidding any person not a resident of the town of Milbridge, in the county of Washington, to dig clams for commercial purposes within the limits of said town. Any person taking clams contrary to the provisions of this rule and regulation shall be punished for each offense by a fine of not more than \$25, or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
