# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Relating to Business Hours for State Stores.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. L., 1935, c. 300, § 9, amended. Section 9 of chapter 300 of the public laws of 1935 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 9. Business hours for state stores. State stores shall not be open on Sundays, court holidays or on the day of the holding of a general election or state-wide primary or between the hours of 78 P. M. and 9. A. M., except on Saturdays when, if open, they may be kept open until 10 P. M., and the liquor commission is hereby authorized to regulate the opening and closing hours of each store within the provisions of this act.

No sales shall be made therein to minors or persons under the influence of liquor.'
