**AN ACT Permitting the County Commissioners of Androscoggin County
to Issue Bonds for South Bridge.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

County commissioners of Androscoggin authorized to make bond issue.

The county commissioners of Androscoggin county may, without obtaining the consent of said county, borrow the sum of \$34,500, which sum shall be a legal debt of the county; and cause notes or obligations of said county with coupons for legal interest to be issued for payment thereof. The amount so borrowed shall be expended in the following manner; \$10,000 to pay obligations created by the building or repairing of Smith bridge, so-called; \$20,000 to refund debt owed to a local bank; \$4,500 to pay damages to property caused by the building of the South bridge, so-called. Said notes or obligations so issued by said county commissioners shall mature in not more than 20 years; and not less than 1/20 of said loan so made shall be raised by taxation and applied in payment of said loan each year after the loan is made.
