RESOLVE, Authorizing Sale of Certain Lands to Eugenia A. Powers.

Authorization to forest commissioner. Resolved: That the authorization given to the forest commissioner, under chapter 22 of the resolves of 1925, to sell and convey consistently with the rights of others, certain lands to Eugenia A. Powers, an actual settler on Township 1, Range 7, west from the east line of the state, in Penobscot county, shall include the right to sell and convey the lands on which the buildings of Eugenia A. Powers are situated and the grass and tillage land, adjacent thereto, now occupied, and used by said Powers.
