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**RESOLVE, in Favor of Augustus D. Phillips, of Northeast Harbor.**

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**Augustus D. Phillips; compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$115 to be paid to Augustus D. Phillips, of Northeast Harbor, to compensate him in full for all claims against the state for damages to his crops destroyed by deer; said sum to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

In 1935, nearly 20% of Mr. Phillips' crops were destroyed, and in 1936 about 77% were destroyed, by deer.
