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**RESOLVE, in Favor of E. O. Brown, of Vassalboro.**

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**E. O. Brown; compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$50 to be paid to E. O. Brown, of Vassalboro, as a full and final settlement against the state for damage by deer to his 24-acre bean patch; said sum to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Deer trampled the bean fields of Mr. Brown, ruining the crops to the extent of \$50.
