STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of J. Ralph Higgins.

J. Ralph Higgins; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, in favor of J. Ralph Higgins, of Dennysville, the sum of \$300 as a full and final settlement against the state for damages to his blueberry crop by deer; said sum to be paid from the funds of the inland fisheries and game.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The deer raided the blueberry field of Mr. Higgins, and destroyed a substantial portion of his crop. The damage being done during a time that the deer were protected.
