RESOLVE, Granting a Bonus for Henry P. Russell, of South Portland.

Henry P. Russell; granted state bonus. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$100 to be paid to Henry P. Russell, of South Portland, as his World War bonus; said sum to be paid from the general state funds.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Every honorably discharged veteran was voted a state bonus of \$100 if application was made by a certain date. Mr. Russell has never filed his application for the state of Maine bonus, but he wishes payment of his bonus.
