## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Archie Robbins, of Biddeford.

Archie Robbins, compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, in favor of Archie Robbins, of Biddeford, the sum of \$7.68 as a full and final settlement against the state for damage to his strawberry patch by deer; said sum to be paid from the funds of the inland fisheries and game.

Mr. Robbins' strawberry patch was damaged by deer to the extent of \$7.68.
