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**RESOLVE, in Favor of J. S. Bryant, of Searsmont.**

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**J. S. Bryant; compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$50 to be paid to J. S. Bryant, of Searsmont, as a full and final settlement against the state, for the loss of a cow killed by a bull moose; said sum to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

On May 22, 1936, Mr. Bryant's cow was killed by a bull moose. Mr. W. E. Bradbury, Chief Warden, investigated.
