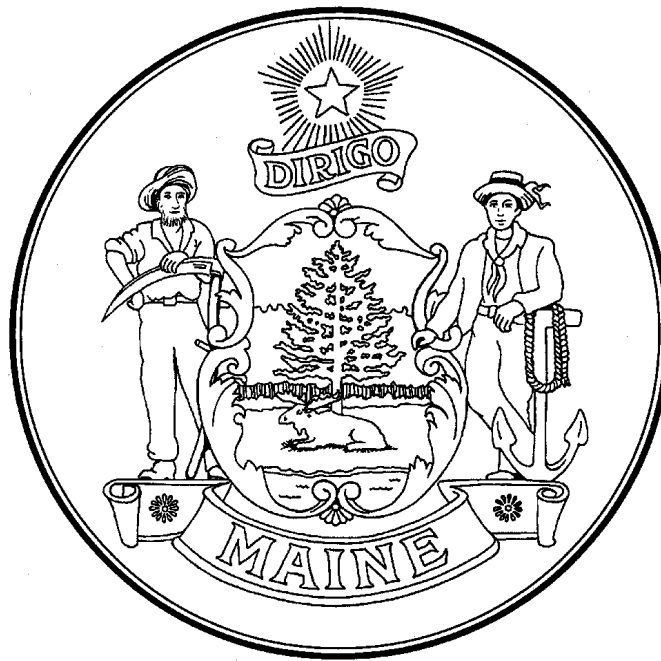

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**RESOLVE**, in Favor of Will T. Libby, of Oxbow.

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**Will T. Libby; compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$80 to be paid to Will T. Libby, of Oxbow, to compensate him for damage done to his camp by bears; said sum to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

This damage to the camp took place between Sept. 30, and Oct. 15, of 1936, and was reported to Game Warden Frank.
