RESOLVE, in Favor of Hoyt F. Parks, of Clifton.

Hoyt F. Parks, compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, in favor of Hoyt F. Parks, of Clifton, the sum of \$20 as a full and final settlement against the state for damage to his bees, hives and honey by bear; to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Bear damaged 2 swarms of bees, honey, and hives on October 17th and 18th, 1936. Claim was approved by Chief Game Warden Raymond Morse.
