William A. Moran; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, in favor of William A. Moran, of Oxbow, the sum of \$33.14 as a full and final settlement against the state, for damage to his camp No. 1 by bears; to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On or about July 1st, 1936, bears came to Mr. Moran's camp No. 1 and tore holes in the cookroom and carried off food supplies. Game Warden Donat Franck was notified.
