RESOLVE, Reimbursing the Town of Stonington, for Support of Harry Taylor.

Town of Stonington; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, in favor of the town of Stonington, the sum of \$478.32 as a full and final settlement against the state for moneys expended for aid to Harry R. Taylor, a veteran of the World War; said sum to be paid from the general state funds.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The overseers of the town of Stonington made a preliminary investigation and gave the towns supposed to be charged with his support the usual and necessary notice but subsequently and after a very careful investigation learned that he was a state charge, although at the time of ascertaining this fact such time passed to bring the items more than 3 months, or over the time limit required for giving notice to municipality as by law required.
