RESOLVE, in Favor of Guy M. Babcock, of West Gardiner.

Guy M. Babcock; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$250 to be held in trust by the department of health and welfare, so much as is necessary to be expended by it for an operation on the knee of Guy M. Babcock, of West Gardiner; and be it further

Resolved: That any unexpended balance of said fund shall be paid to the treasurer of state; and be it further

Resolved: That the payment of the expenses of the aforesaid operation shall be a settlement in full for all injuries received by said Babcock while employed by the state highway department.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Babcock was employed as a state highway foreman on July 28, 1929, when the injury happened.
