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**Henry L. Martin; compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of Henry L. Martin, of Boston, Massachusetts, the sum of \$50 as a full and final settlement for claims against the state, for damage to his car by deer; said sum to be paid from the funds of the inland fisheries and game department.
