IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of John Ruggles, of Carmel.

John Ruggles of Carmel; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$780.75 to be paid to John Ruggles, of Carmel to compensate him in full for all claims against the state for damages done to his filling station and store by Ralph Doucette, a paroled convict; said sum to be paid from the general state funds.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Ralph Doucette was sentenced to serve 2 to 4 years at the state prison, on July 6, 1933. He was paroled June 22, 1935. On July 21, 1936, he broke into and entered stores at St. Albans, Hartland, and Palmyra. While being pursued by Mr. Weeks, of Palmyra, he ran into the filling station and store of John Ruggles, to the damage of John Ruggles of \$780.75.
