IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Calais School District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Effective date of S. P. 409, L. D. 786 clarified. S. P. 409, L. D. 786 of the 88th legislature entitled "An Act to Incorporate the Calais School District" is hereby amended by striking out the 1st sentence of section 8 thereof, and inserting the following in place thereof:

'This act shall take effect 90 days after the adjournment of this legislature for the purpose of permitting its acceptance or rejection by the legal voters of the city of Calais at any special meeting legally called to consider the acceptance of this act', and by adding at the end thereof the following words, 'This act shall become operative immediately upon said declaration.'
