RESOLVE, in Favor of Anton R. Jordan, of Osborne Plantation.

Anton R. Jordan; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$45 to be paid to Anton R. Jordan, of Osborne Plantation, as a full and final settlement against the state for damages to his blueberry field caused by bears and deer; said sum to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In 1935, bears and deer destroyed berries valued at \$1.25 per bushel, and in 1936 destroyed 35 bushels valued at \$1.75 per bushel.
