**RESOLVE, Relative to the Participation by the State of Maine in the  
New York World's Fair to be held in the Year 1939.**

---

**Participation in New York World's Fair. Resolved:** That for the purpose of exhibiting the recreational advantages, arts, industries, institutions, resources, products and general development of the state of Maine at the New York world's fair to be held in the year 1939, the Maine Development Commission shall act as the Maine commission for the New York world's fair. The said commission shall have charge of the interests of the state and its citizens in the preparation and exhibition at the said fair of the natural and industrial products of the state and of objects illustrating its history, progress, moral and material welfare and plans for its future development, and of all other matters relating to said fair. The commission shall communicate with the officers of the fair and shall obtain and disseminate throughout the state all necessary information regarding the fair, and in general shall have and exercise full authority in relation to the participation of the state and its citizens in the fair.
