STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Registration of Stone-Crushers, Well-Drillers,
Graders, Rollers and Wood-Sawing Outfits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1937. c. 196, amended. Chapter 196 of the public laws of 1937 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'R. S., c. 29, § 54, amended. Section 54 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting at the end of subdivision "c" the following:

Stone-crushers, air compressors, ~~power shovels or cranes~~, graders, rollers, well-drillers and wood-sawing equipment, any of which are permanently mounted on a traction unit or motor chassis, shall be registered and a fee of \$10 shall be paid for such registration in lieu of all other registration fees.

It is further provided that the movement over the highways of any of the above described equipment, the weight of which is in excess of 10 tons, shall be subject to the provisions of section 21 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes, as amended, and permits to move said equipment shall be obtained accordingly.

Provided, however, that notwithstanding anything herein contained, no operator's or chauffeur's license shall be required for the movement over the highways of Maine of the above described equipment.'
