RESOLVE, Authorizing Compensation for George E. Googins, of Bar Harbor.

George E. Googins; compensated. Resolved: That the treasurer of the county of Hancock be, and hereby is, authorized, empowered and directed to pay to George E. Googins, of Bar Harbor, the sum of \$600 for additional services as recorder of the Bar Harbor municipal court for the period from September, 1935 to February, 1937.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Googins acted as Recorder and Judge for a period of 2 years without the additional salary of Judge. He is 75 years of age and in poor health. Mr. Googins has served as Recorder for 20 years.
