AN ACT to Regulate the Powers of Municipalities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 5, § 136, amended. Section 136 of chapter 5 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to be numbered VIII-A, and to read as follows:

‘VIII-A. To make the tenure of the office of a superintendent of a cemetery or a superintendent of burials permanent, and provide that the incumbent shall be removable only for cause, or removal from the municipality in which the cemetery is located.’
