AN ACT Exempting Certain Aged Citizens from the Payment of a Poll Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 13, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following :

‘All male citizens of the state are hereby exempted from the payment of such poll tax after said male citizens shall have arrived at the age of 70 years.’
