IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Relative to Fishing in North Pond, East Pond and East Pond Stream.

Fishing in North pond, East pond, and East pond stream. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening North pond, East pond and East Pond stream in Smithfield to fishing each day except Sunday for pickerel, horn pout, and yellow perch, during the autumn season until ice forms upon the waters thereof, and thereafter to ice fishing for one day in each week until the ice goes out in the spring.
